EPA AND TERRAPASS RECOGNIZE PORTIONPAC CHEMICAL CORPORATION AMONG NATION'S LEADING GREEN POWER PURCHASERS

PURCHASE SUPPORTS NEW DEVELOPMENT OF CLEAN RENEWABLE RESOURCES
